

## **Nuna to Continue Helping Expand CMS Medicaid Data Capabilities**

SAN FRANCISCO, Calif., January 30, 2018—Nuna is proud to announce continuing work to support the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS). Nuna, as a subcontractor to TISTA, was awarded contracts to continue to develop the Transformed-Medicaid Statistical Information System (T-MSIS), as well as CMS's comprehensive Medicaid data warehouse for the Medicaid and CHIP Business Information Solutions (MACBIS) program.

Since late 2014, Nuna has supported CMS with the transition to a standardized national platform to store operational data from Medicaid and CHIP, including information about enrollees, services, and costs; beneficiary eligibility; claims and encounter data; and provider enrollment data. Currently there are 48 states actively submitting data to T-MSIS, covering more than 95% of the Medicaid population. Upon completion, the MACBIS data warehouse will contain a comprehensive set of Medicaid information resources, including standardized data on state Medicaid programs, financial information, and operational and pharmacy data.

This work, to be carried out over the next five years, has enormous potential to improve the information infrastructure for the Medicaid and CHIP programs, and in turn to enable policymakers and others to improve the program for its enrollees across the country. "We are humbled by CMS's continued decision to entrust Nuna with these critical programs", said Jini Kim, Founder and CEO of Nuna. "We are so honored to help equip CMS with the systems to enable program monitoring, policy development, and research."

Nuna and TISTA's approach combines Medicaid data systems know-how with expertise using agile development techniques. Nuna and TISTA are committed to using modern and open-source technologies, which enable them to create secure and scalable data architecture.

The continuation of this work also represents Nuna's enduring commitment to making high quality healthcare affordable and accessible for everyone.
